## A NEUROLOGY PIONEER **IN ZAMBIA**

**Dr. Stanley** Zimba

In 2023, Cures Within Reach funded **Dr. Stanley Zimba** at the **University** of Zambia to study the addition of a high blood pressure drug, losartan, to standard of care for drug-resistant epilepsy patients.

In addition to his role in Internal Medicine at University of Zambia School of Medicine, Dr. Zimba is a Consulting Neurologist at the University Teaching Hospital in Lusaka. His fellowship there focused on clinical characteristics, risk factors and endothelial dysfunction in people with HIV and stroke in Zambia. He was a Fogarty Fellow at Harvard's T.H. Chan School of Public Health and received an International Scholarship Award from the American Academy of Neurology.

Dr. Zimba became interested in neurology while a resident in internal medicine after seeing the huge burden of neurological diseases in Zambia without specialists. He is a budding researcher: one of his career goals is to contribute to developing, evaluating and implementing innovative and cost-effective interventions for the prevention and treatment of stroke in Zambia, across sub-Saharan Africa and globally.



## **Profile**

Stanley Zimba received Doctorate and Masters of Medicine from University of Zambia, and is now a consultant neurologist at University Teaching Hospital in Lusaka. He was one of the first neurologists trained in Zambia.
